
RED BARREL GIVING REBOUNDS IN 2014

Des Moines, IA—While unemployment here in Iowa has remained relatively steady—fluctuating between 4.2 and 4.6 percent over the last year or so—the Consumer Confidence Index nationwide managed to bounce back toward the end of the year, punctuated by a marked increase in holiday spending in December. This may, in part, account for the increase in donor giving DMARC experienced this year. And while many farmers voiced concerns over falling corn and soybean prices this year, fresh produce donations from family farms, produce distributors, grocery stores, and community gardens increased dramatically here at the DMARC warehouse throughout the summer months and on into the fall. Unfortunately, the need amongst food pantry clients also went up.


Food donations through DMARC's Red Barrel Program this year totaled 117,683 items, an increase of just about 3.5% from last year. Garnering the top spot for a second year in a row was the Dahl's Food Store on 35th & Ingersoll (serviced by the Downtown Kiwanis Club), which collected a total of 10,427 food items this year, followed by the Hy-Vee on Ankeny Blvd. (serviced by Link Associates) with 8,615 items and the Dahl's on Merle Hay Rd. (serviced by the Johnston Kiwanis) with 6,628 items. Overall, Hy-Vee stores came out on top this year, drawing 43,910 food items from their customers and donating over 18,000 discarded food items from their own inventories. Dahl's Food Stores saw the closing of two of it's Red Barrel locations: the Dahl's store in Ankeny and the Dahl's store on Prospect in West Des Moines. Despite this, a combined total of 40,218 food items were collected areawide. Fareway Stores brought in 6,104 food items collectively. And the independent grocery store, Brick Street Market & Café, which recently opened for business in Bondurant, joined the Red Barrel program in August bringing in 1,708 food items in just five short months.

The Hunger Sack program, of which 22 stores currently participate, saw a slight shift in sales from last year. Again, just over 6,000 sacks were sold. But this year, more 6-item sacks (about 5,154) and fewer 12-item sacks (about 926) were sold. The Hy-Vee on S. 51st & Mills Civic Pkwy. sold the most 6-item Hunger Sacks this year with 704 while the Dahl's on 35th & Ingersoll sold the most 12-item Hunger Sacks with 423. The Dahl's at 50th & E.P. True Pkwy. also had a strong showing once again this year selling 558 6-item Hunger Sacks and the Hy-Vee on Fleur & McKinley came in third, selling 503 6-item sacks. Combined sack sale leaders this year were Dahl's on Ingersoll with 739 (316 6-item; 423 12-item), Hy-Vee N. Ankeny Blvd. with 682 (406 6-item; 276 12-item), and Dahl's E.P. True with 575 (558 6-item; 17 12-item).
