So far in 2015...

the Red Barrel Program has collected:

48,262 food items, **1,246** personal care items, **167** baby diapers, **8** cans of baby formula, **3,383** lbs. of rescued produce, and **\$2,446.75** in cash and checks.

Also: **1,887** 6-item Hunger Sacks and **340** 12-item Hunger Sacks have been purchased through participating grocery stores.

FAREWAY ADDS WEST DES MOINES LOCATION



West Des Moines, IA—After many months of construction, Boonebased Eareway Stores Inc. cut the ribbon on its 111th location just west

based Fareway Stores, Inc. cut the ribbon on its 111th location just west of 63rd and Grand near Valley Junction in West Des Moines. The brand new building, located at 329 Grand Avenue (site of a former, family entertainment complex), opened for business on Wednesday, July 1st at 10:00 a.m. Leading the new team are Grocery Manager Wil Goldberg (former manager of the S.E. 22nd Street location), Assistant Grocery Manager Andrew DeGroote, Meat Manager Mike Lensch, and Assistant Meat Manager Jake Jurgens. The retro–looking façade of the new building includes maroon brick, a vintage sign, and uniquely designed steel latticework to match the existing artwork of its municipal surroundings. The interior of the new facility includes a meat department (which Fareway stores are well-known for), a prepared-foods section, and a bakery that will serve several other Fareway locations in the greater Des Moines area with fresh bread items and pastries daily.
